

# Police Evidence Technician – Basic

Our comprehensive two-week program is widely attended by individuals from local, state and federal agencies and will provide your personnel with a solid forensic foundation to work effectively in the field. Topics include criminal and case law regarding crime scene investigations, fingerprint processing, diagramming, photography, impression evidence, biological evidence, trace evidence and specific types of crime scenes such as burglary, robbery, death, sexual assault, fire and crash investigations.



The instructor provides perspectives of both the laboratory expert and the experienced crime scene investigator. This program utilizes a hands-on/cooperative learning group method of instruction to assist participants in understanding and retaining the information presented and has been considered highly useful based on past participant feedback.

This program is approved by the Illinois Law Enforcement Training Standards Board and is also approved as Lead Homicide Investigator Training. Participants must bring departmental camera, tripod, and flash.
