This is an intermediate-level workshop designed to increase the effectiveness of the crime scene examiner in locating, documenting, and recovering latent print evidence.

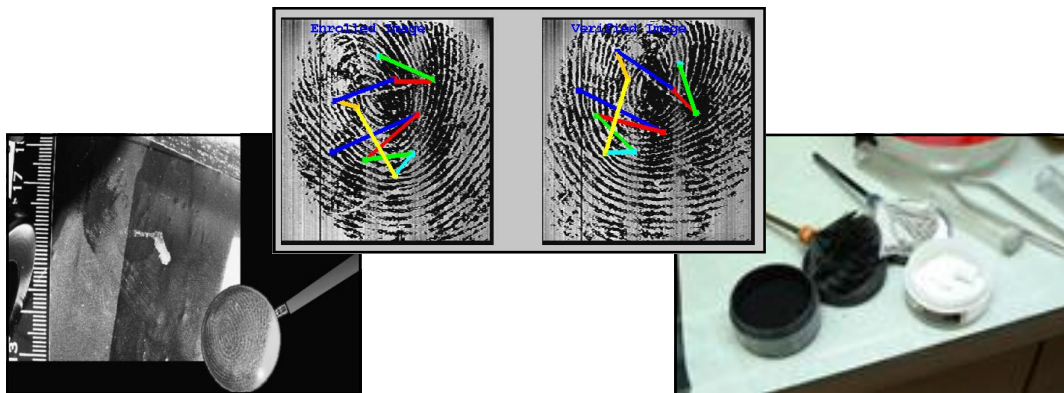
Students will work with a variety of processing methods that will improve their skills in recovering prints.
